## **DH Independent Project Agreement**

The student understands that the faculty member is not obligated to agree to this arrangement. In entering into this agreement, the student certifies that they have working knowledge of DH projects and methods, and they understand what a DH project will entail. The student will not expect the professor to provide any additional DH instruction. The student and faculty member agree that the student will work on a digital humanities (DH) project as part of course. The DH project will replace Here are the primary elements of the DH project: 1. A mandatory consultation with the program chair (Hilary Havens) and the digital scholarship librarian (Joshua Ortiz Baco) in order to scope the project and ensure its feasibility; 2. The executed DH element of the project, specifically (to be filled out after #1 above is completed); 3. (Optional) A \_\_\_\_\_ class presentation of the DH project;

4. A substantive written component, satisfying the goals of the course, and whose length and

content should be determined by the instructor;

5. A supplementary 1-page paper describing the methodology used to create the DH Project that should be included in the student's Portfolio at the end of the DH certificate.

## **Evaluation of the Final DH Project**

The professor will evaluate the final project according to how well it meets disciplinary standards and exemplifies the overarching aims of the course.
